If the Owner requests the Contractor to submit a proposal for a change in the work and then elects not to proceed with the change, a change order shall be issued to reimburse the Contractor for any costs incurred for design services, bid preparation or proposed revisions to the contract documents, with the addition of a change in time.

The Contractor shall be compensated for changes in the work necessitated by the enactment or revisions or codes, laws or regulations subsequent to the submission of the Contractor's proposal.
